The Arts and Me – Writing a Cover Sheet

You will be asked to bring a presentation piece to the Arts Workshop. Choose something that reflects your artistic interests and personality.

This presentation piece may be:

- a portfolio of 3 pieces of art that are recent, different and original
- a piece of music (instrumental or vocal to be performed without accompaniment)
- a dance (bring your own CD)
- a dramatic presentation (monologue, scene from a play, etc.) maximum 3 minutes

How Do I Write A Cover Sheet?

The cover sheet should briefly describe your presentation piece. Then, in greater detail, explain why you selected this piece. What can we learn about you, your special interests and talents from your presentation?

Sample ideas to get you started on your cover sheet are:

- I chose this piece to share because...
- I am proud of this piece of work because...
- This item shows how I enjoy the arts because...
- This work demonstrates what I know about... I will tell you why.
