

L.D.S.B. Student Trustee Application

Date of Election: Monday, May 9th, 2016

Location: Limestone DSB Interschool Council Meeting, to be held at Loyalist CVI, 153 Van Order Drive in Kingston

Time: 9:00 am – 11:00 am.

Eligibility for Student Trustee

- a) be registered as a full-time Senior division student in one of the Board's secondary schools for the upcoming year or an exceptional pupil in a special education program for whom the Board has reduced the length of the instructional program on each school day under subsection 3(3) of Regulation 298 of the Revised Regulations of Ontario, 1990 (Operation of Schools – General) made under the Act, so long as the pupil would be a full-time pupil if the program had not been reduced;
- b) have obtained an overall average of at least seventy per cent in the current school year;
- c) have demonstrated respect for the school's code of student conduct;
- d) have appropriate parental permission if the student is under 18 years of age;
- e) have sufficiently completed the required written application by the deadline of Friday May 6th, 2016 at 6:00 pm.

There will be one student trustee representing urban schools, and one representing rural schools.

Urban Schools: LCVI, KCVI, BSS, FSS, LSS **Rural Schools:** ESS, NDSS, SHS, NAEC, GREC

In addition, all candidates are required to prepare a speech, not exceeding two minutes, to present to the Interschool Council on May 9th, 2016.

The successful candidate will be registered and expected to attend the Ontario Student Trustee Conference in Toronto May 26-29, 2016 with expenses paid for the conference by the L.D.S.B.

Candidates will be notified of the receipt of their application within one day of submission.

- Written answers to the following questions, each not exceeding 300 words:
 - o Why do you want to be an urban/rural student trustee representing the Limestone DSB?
 - o What experience do you have that would make you a unique candidate?
 - o Are you passionate about the student voice? How will you ensure that the student voice is heard within the Interschool Council, at the Limestone Board Table, and with the provincial student trustee body - OSTA-AECO?
